- Nursery hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- Two to three caring staff and/or volunteers are on duty at all times.
- Staff are First Aid & CPR certified.
- Individual areas for infant nursery and toddler room. All children age 2 and under are welcome.
- Healthy snack provided by nursery (juice & and labeled sippy cups should be provided by parents.)
- Children should have individual bags with diapers/pull-ups and extra clothes.
- Sign in and sign out procedures are used to ensure child's safety.
- Nursery provided beepers are used to notify parents if need be during Sunday school and services.
- Health and Wellness checklist followed to ensure health of children in the nursery. (See posted checklist)
- Please remember that it may take your child a few visits to become comfortable with us. He/she may cry the first few times they visit with us, but we will do all that we can to make them feel welcome. The more often your child comes, the easier the transition will be. Our policy is to only allow a child to cry for 15 minutes before paging the parent. If you prefer a shorter or longer time frame, please notify the nursery staff when dropping off your child.
- To ensure all the children's safety, fire and inclement weather procedures have been established. In the event the fire alarm is triggered, all children will exit the building and be escorted by the nursery staff to the nearest fire exit and will proceed to the far corner of the parking lot next to Bare Bones on East Main Street... Please do not try to come back to the nursery. In the event of inclement weather, the children will be escorted to the lowest level of the Christian Life Center until the weather threat has passed
