Adult Ministry

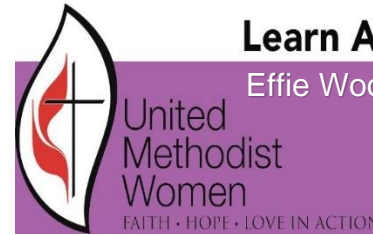


Helping men grow in Christ so that others will know Christ.
