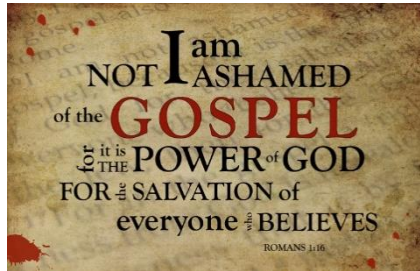

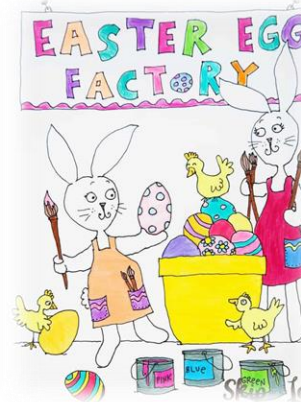
Young At Heart in March
