

Young at Heart: Swan House & Gardens and Smith Farm - RSVP by Tuesday, April 8.

Swan House is included on the list of National Historic Places. It was built in 1924 for wealthy businessman Edward Inman (cotton broker, real estate, transportation, and banking), and his wife Emily (philanthropist, political advocate, and socialite). The renowned architect Philip Trammell Shutze designed the house and gardens. In 1966 the Atlanta Historical Society purchased the house, and establishing a museum which opened in 1967. The Swan house was featured in the Hunger Games films Catching Fire and Mockingjay. The Smith Farm is a small plantation farmhouse, built c. 1840 by Robert and Elizabeth Smith. It is Atlanta's oldest surviving farmhouse. Cost: \$20.00 entrance fee + 2.00 gas = \$22.00. We will be leaving the church at 10:00am, returning around 3:00pm. Lunch will be on your own at OK Café.
